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In June, WHO delivered a consignment of 2000 viral transport medias units to a laboratory in Idleb to scale up COVID-19 surveillance and testing capacity in northwest Syria.

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In April, WHO delivered 5000 dry swabs, and 5000 PCR testing and 5000 extraction units to a laboratory in Idleb to scale up COVID-19 surveillance and testing capacity in
