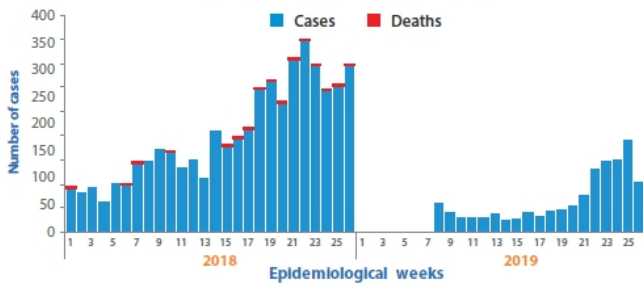

Trends of cholera cases and deaths in Somalia from week 26/2018 to week 26/2019



Summary statistics

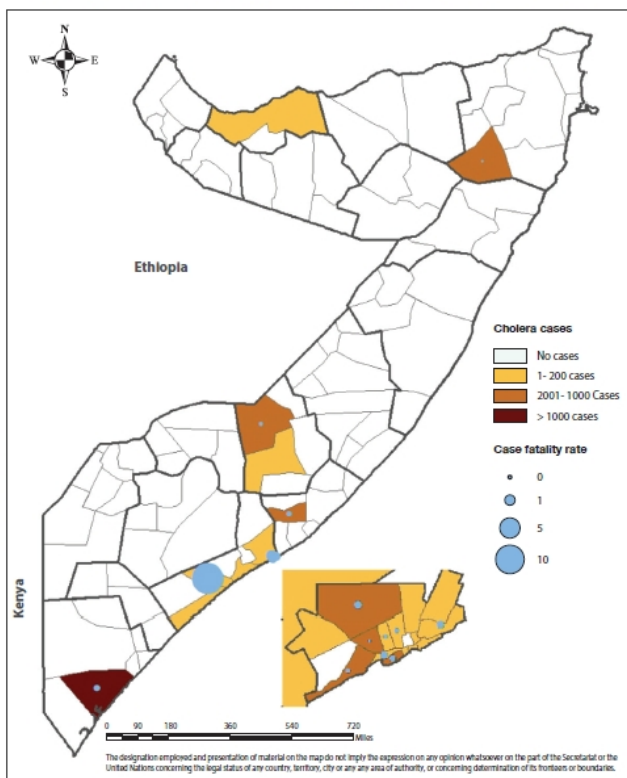
- 144** new cases of Cholera were reported during week 26, of which **98 (68%)** are children below 5 years
- 8,138** cumulative cases were reported since December 2017 of which **4,970 (61.1%)** are children below 5 years **3,914 (48%)** cases were amongst females
- Cumulative **46** deaths were reported since December 2017

Highlights

- During week 26, 144 new cases and no deaths were reported from 14 districts of Banadir region and one district of Gedo.
- Since December 2017, a total of 8,138 cumulative cases including 46 deaths (CFR 0.6%) were reported from 3 states of Somalia (Hirshabelle, Jubaland and South West state) and Banadir region.
- Since December 2017 a cumulative attack rate of 186 person per 100,000 population was reported with Kismayo (Jubaland) and Daynile (Banadir) the most affected.
- The overall case Fatality Rate (CFR 0.6%) was reported with Daynile, Waberi, Karan and Kurtunwarey exceeding the WHO's threshold of <1%.
