

Highlights Cholera situation in Somalia, September 2016 update

- As of October 2016, a cumulative number of 13 728 acute watery diarrhoea/cholera cases and 496 (case–fatality rate 3.6%) deaths were reported in 25 districts. Of these 6 520 (47.5%) are women, while 7 968 (58.0%) are children below 5 years.
 - As shown in the EPI curve, there was a significant reduction (34%) in the number of cases reported from 164 cases and zero deaths in September to 108 cases and zero
 - Of the 108 cases of acute watery diarrhoea/cholera cases reported, 90 cases were from Banadir and 18 from Beledweyne. \Box

 - Since January 2016, the most affected districts are Banadir, Kismayo, Sakow, Bu'ale, Jowhar, Belet-Hawo and Jalalaqsi.
