



Food insecurity and malnutrition

- 32** Patients Reportedly died of malnutrition
- 1.1 million people experiencing catastrophic food insecurity IPC Phase 5
- 31% of children 6-23 months old in north Gaza are malnourished

Long-term conditions in Gaza

2K+ People diagnosed with cancer each year including 122 children

220K People with high blood pressure

60K+ Patients living with diabetes

45K Patients living with cardiovascular disease

1K+ Patients in need of kidney dialysis to maintain life

485K+ People with mental health disorders*

59 Communities in West Bank have no access to primary health care

Ongoing Response



 Reached an estimated **1.8M** people with various health services

 **182K+** Trauma and emergency care interventions provided

 **5.7M+** Primary health care consultations

 **4.8K+** Patients referred abroad through the Rafah crossing

 **660K+** People provided with basic mental health and psychosocial support

Gaza Strip

 **\$104M+** Worth of supplies procured
\$64M+ Worth of supplies delivered

 **10** Field hospitals established to support case management

 **15** Emergency Medical Teams (EMTs) deployed weekly (on average) to support health response

 **10M+** Litres of fuel used to maintain functional health facilities and partner operations

 **150K+** children immunized

 **233K+** ante- and post-natal consultations

West Bank

 **468K+** People with various health services reached

 **6K+** Trauma and emergency care interventions provided

 **32K+** People provided with mental health and psychosocial support

 **120K+** people benefiting from Maintaining prepositioned supplies

 **274K+** Primary health care consultations provided to marginalized communities in Area C

Operational challenges



 High insecurity

 Limited access to locations in the north

 **275** Humanitarian workers killed; **498** health workers killed

 Displacement

 Collapse of the formal market and lack of cash

Gaza Strip

 Shortage of medical supplies and equipment

 Social stresses affecting capacity of staff to work and leading to brain drain

 Poor telecommunications

 Lack of access to basic amenities including food, WASH, shelter

 Fuel shortages

West Bank

 Checkpoint closures and movement restrictions

 Increased military operations and settler violence

 Obstructed access for ambulances, health care workers, and patients

 Community displacements




Partners presence in Gaza Strip

Total 34 partners


