



Operational challenges



High insecurity



Limited access to locations in the north



283 Humanitarian workers killed; **885** health workers killed



Repeated mass displacements



Collapse of the formal market and lack of cash

Shortage of medical supplies and equipment



Social stresses affecting capacity of staff to work



Poor telecommunications



Lack of access to basic amenities including food, WASH, shelter



Limited access to fuel

West Bank



Checkpoint closures and movement restrictions



Increased military operations and settler violence



Obstructed access for ambulances, health care workers, and patients



Community displacements



Permits not being renewed



Economic crisis affecting MoH and the population at large affecting access to health services




Partners presence in Gaza Strip


