Sudan cVDPV2 Outbreak Response Situation Report, No. 21
Data as of Week 20

Situation Overview:

- In 2021, there is no reported cVDPV2 case. The most recent confirmed cVDPV2 case
 (SUD.SDA.2020.042) was notified reported from South Darfur with date of onset 18 December 2020.
- During the previous week, the National Polio Laboratory (NPL) reported one L20B positive isolates from the environmental sample, collected April 2021. Final classification is pending.
- In 2020, Sudan country program reported a total of 58 confirmed circulatory vaccine derived polio virus 2 (cVDPV2) cases, (3 confirmed by contacts), 14 positive contacts and 4 healthy children (HC) in 15 states, as well as, isolation of cVDPV2 from sewage samples in Khartoum state.
- In 2021, The Total AFP cases were 202, out of them 170 were discarded as Non-Polio AFP cases, and 32 cases pending classification.
- The team has been working on analysis of report from the internal AFP surveillance review in four states
 of North Darfur, Central Darfur, West Kordofan and Northern states. Country team is developing a
 detailed plan of action to implement recommendations and further enhance quality of AFP surveillance
 system.


Vaccine Management:

- Remaining stock of mOPV2 stand at 1,903,480 doses and are stored at the national and state cold stores
 under closely monitored temperature till further advise on action from Outbreak Preparedness and
 Response Task Teams (OPRTT).
- Development of country readiness for nOPV2 (vaccine management component) had started.


Communications and C4D (Communications for Development):

- Focal person from HP is nominated to participate in the nOPV2 readiness process and the Regional calls.
- Social mobilization activities for COVID-19 vaccination also focusing on message dissemination regarding importance of both polio and routine vaccination.
