AFP / ENVIRONMENTAL

- 326 children with Acute Flaccid Paralysis (AFP) were reported in July: 152 girls and 174 boys. A total of 2,962 AFP cases have been reported since the beginning of 2022. Of these, 2,680 cases have been discarded as non-polio. Around 280 cases are pending final classification.
- The non-polio AFP rate is 23, stool adequacy stood above 94%, and non-polio enterovirus rate is above 19% at national level.
- In all regions, non-polio AFP rate is above 16, stool adequacy above 89%, and non polio enterovirus rate is ranging from 16-23%.



SUPPLEMENTARY VACCINATION

 More than 7 million children were vaccinated during the sub national campaign that took place in 28 provinces from 25 - 28 July. The campaign targetted high risk mobile populations as well as cold districts that missed campaigns during the winter months.



- 13 cross-border vaccination points, 45 cross-border teams and 328 permanent transit teams were operational in July.
- Permanent transit teams vaccinated 83,216 children, and cross-border teams vaccinated 95,152 children against polio this month.
- 1,577 children under 10 were given OPV in UNHCR repatriation centres and IOM sites receiving returnees and refugees from Pakistan and Iran in July.
- From January 1st 2022 to date, 19,741 returnee children were vaccinated with OPV, 538 received IPV and 2.503 received measles vaccine.
- 416 international travelers were vaccinated this month in compliance with International Health Regulations.



Key communication activities

- 395,177 caregivers, including 139,587 women, were engaged on issues related to polio, routine immunization, maternal and child health promotion, and COVID-19 preventative measures in the West, East and South-East Regions.
- 412,622 children under five were given polio vaccine drops, 20,585 children under two were vaccinated for routine immunization and 15,703 women and girls received Tetanus vaccine across the targetted health facilities.
- 425,406 females were reached with polio, and mother and child health awareness messages by female mobilizers/vaccinators through 14,249 sessions across targetted health facilities in the South-East, West and East Regions.
- 2,880 individuals, including religious influencers, local authorities and community influencers were engaged to increase the uptake of polio vaccines, reduce refusals and track missed children in the South-East, West and East Regions.
