

OLIO TRANSMISSION

• No Wild Poliovirus (WPV1) case was confirmed in April 2022



- 272 children with Acute Flaccid Paralysis (AFP) were reported in March: 122 females and 150 males. A total of 1,454 AFP cases have been reported since the beginning of 2022. Of these, 1,193 cases have been discarded as non-polio. Around 259 cases are pending final classification
- The non-polio AFP rate is 14, stool adequacy stood above 94%, and non-polio enterovirus rate was 14% in all regions
- In all regions, non-polio AFP rate is above 10, stool adequacy above 90%, and non polio enterovirus rate is ranging from 9 - 17%.
- An extensive internal AFP surveillance review took place in selected key districts in all provinces in the last week of April.



SUPPLEMENTARY VACCINATION

• There was no campaign in April.



- 12 cross-border vaccination points, 45 cross-border teams and 336 permanent transit teams (PTTs) were operational in April.
- Permanent transit teams vaccinated 659,243 children, and cross-border teams vaccinated 66,516 children against polio this month.
- 1,238 children under 10 were given OPV in UNHCR repatriation centres and IOM sites receiving returnees and refugees from Pakistan and Iran in
- From January 1st 2022 to date, 9,482 returnee children were vaccinated with OPV, 316 received IPV and 935 received measles vaccine.
- 449 international travelers were vaccinated this month in compliance with IHR.



Key communication activities

- 1,934 caregivers, including 892 women, were engaged on issues related to polio, routine immunization, maternal and child health promotion, and COVID-19 preventative measures in the West, South, South-East and North-East regions
- 354,603 children under five were given polio vaccine drops, 29,907 children under two were vaccinated for routine immunization and 16,841 women and girls received Tetanus vaccine across the targetted health facilities
- 45,149 females were reached with polio, and mother and child health awareness messages by female mobilizers/vaccinators across 346 health facilities in the South, South-East, West and East regions.
- 1,348 individuals, including religious influencers, local authorities and community influencers were engaged to increase the uptake of polio vaccines, reduce refusals and track missed children in the South, South-East, West and North-East regions.
- 756 mothers of street working children were reached with polio education messages and child healthcare tips in the West region.
- 33,052 soap bars and 5,000 polio-branded baby blankets were distributed to individuals and health centres in the West and North-East regions
