

OLIO TRANSMISSION

• Two new Wild Poliovirus (WPV1) cases and no new cVDPV2 cases confirmed in November 2021



AFP / ENVIRONMENTAL

- 316 children with Acute Flaccid Paralysis (AFP) - 132 females and 184 males - were reported in November 2021. A total of 3.758 AFP cases have been reported since the beginning of 2021. Of these, 3,494 cases have been discarded as non-polio. About 214 cases are pending final classification
- The non-polio AFP rate remained above 10, stool adequacy stood above 94%, and non-polio enterovirus rate was 19% in all regions
- No new WPV1 and no new cVDPV2 positive environmental samples were confirmed in November 2021



• 8,572,717 children were vaccinated against polio during the November NIDs



- 12 cross-border vaccination points, 45 crossborder teams and 619 permanent transit teams (PTTs) were operational in November 2021
- Permanent transit teams vaccinated 855.846 children, and cross-border teams vaccinated 130,373 children against polio in November 2021
- 988 children under 10 were given OPV in **UNHCR** repatriation centre and IOM sites receiving returnees and refugees from Pakistan and Iran in November 2021
- Between January to end of November 2021, 13,159 returnee children were vaccinated with OPV and 1,059 children with IPV, respectively
- 297 international travelers were vaccinated in November 2021 in compliance with IHR



Key communication activities

- 379,572 caregivers were engaged on issues related to polio, routine immunization, maternal and child health promotion, and COVID-19 preventative measures in south, west, and northeast regions
- 320,019 children under five were given polio vaccine drops, 25,050 children under two were vaccinated for routine immunization and 12,792 women and girls received Tetanus vaccine across the target health facilities
- 576,856 females were reached with polio and mother and child health awareness messages by the female mobilizers/vaccinators (FMVs) through 51,603 face-to-face sessions in the east, west, and south regions
- 2.041 individuals, including religious influencers, local authorities and community influencers were reached with awareness in the south, west, and north-east regions
- 155,134 soap bars, and 42,214 baby blankets were distributed to target health centres in the south, east, and west regions
- 47,318 children and adults received referrals by ICN (32,454 specifically made for routine immunization) in the south and northeast regions. 52% of the referrals have been utilized
