



HIGHLIGHTS

- The mortalities were a 66 years old female Bahraini citizen and a 50 years old male expatriate.
- A crackdown on illegal slaughterhouses has been urged ahead of Eid Al Adha to ensure the health and safety of people in light of COVID-19.
- The Primary Care Infection Control Unit carries out preventive measures in all health centres.
- In more than 2 months, the total number of active cases is less than 4,000 for the second day in a row.
- UN report forecasts increase in hunger and malnutrition globally as a result of COVID-19; in 2019 it was estimated that 690 million people went hungry, by the end of 2020 the number may increase by an additional 130 million, see link helow
