### **HIGHLIGHTS**

- The mortality was a 61 year old male expatriate.
- A man who tested positive for the coronavirus will stand trial in court for deliberately trying to infect doctors with COVID-19 by coughing on them.
- A new multilingual survey aimed at gauging the awareness of the COVID-19 pandemic among Bahrain's expatriate population has been launched.
- Northern Governorate: Distributing over 7,500 food parcels launched by the Royal Humanitarian Foundation in cooperation with the Ministry of Interior to contribute to mitigating the effects of the pandemic.
- UN report forecasts increase in hunger and malnutrition globally as a result of COVID-19; in 2019 it was estimated that 690 million people went hungry, by the end of 2020 the number may increase by an additional 130 million, see link below.
