HIGHLIGHTS

• The mortality was a 21 year old male citizen.

• MoH: people have been urged to follow all health guidelines and avoid family gatherings to avoid an increase in COVID-19 cases during Eid Al Adha.

• MoH: 89.65% is the recovery rate from the total active cases while the death rate is 0.34%.

• The capacity of the isolation and treatment centres is 8,357 beds, of which 2,083 beds are occupied representing 25% of the capacity.

• UN report forecasts increase in hunger and malnutrition globally as a result of COVID-19; in 2019 it was estimated that 690 million people went hungry, by the end of 2020 the number may increase by an additional 130 million, see link below.




