#### **HIGHLIGHTS**

- The mortalities were a 60 years old male Bahraini citizen and 2 male expatriates (60 and 65 years old).
- The Minister of Health conducts field visits to various testing, isolation and treatment centres.
- MoH promotes preventive measures to avoid coronavirus surge during Eid Al Adha.
- More than 15,000 masks-related violations recorded.
- The Prime Minister allocates \$200,000 to celebrate Bahrain's Doctor's Day and the "Khalifa Bin Salman" Award.
- Volunteers of the Bahrain Red Crescent Society were trained to provide psychological support in a virtual training programme "Remote psychological first aid to tackle Covid-19".
