HIGHLIGHTS

- The mortalities were 10 Bahraini citizens [2 female (56 and 84 years old) and 8 male (50, 52, 64, 64, 66,74,75 and 82 years old)], and 7 expatriates [1 female (43 year old) and 6 male (48, 53, 53, 55, 57, and 68 years old).
- Assistant Undersecretary for Primary Care called to take advantage of the available remote provision of health services.
- The International Organization for Migration praised Bahrain's efforts in implementing "smart solutions" to prevent the spread of (Covid-19) among migrant workers.
- Bahrain has been witnessing a spike in divorce cases during Covid-19 with "trivial" issues.
- The Philippines Embassy in Bahrain announced the closure of its premises until further notice after two of their frontline personnel tested positive for Covid-19.
- A parliamentary delegation has participated in a webinar convened by the Inter-Parliamentary Union remotely to discuss the effects of the Coronavirus pandemic on the implementation of the sustainable development goals and the impact on climate change.
- Bahrain is among the world's first countries to have tested 50 % of its population for Covid-19.
- \bullet 900 violations for not wearing a mask during Eid Al-Adha.
- Resuming the movement of Bahraini trucks to Saudi Arabia via king Fahd Causeway on 2 August.
