HIGHLIGHTS

- The mortality was a 85 years old female Bahraini Citizen.
- MOH participated in the regular meeting of the Executive Body of the Health Council of the Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) Countries for following up on strategies, plans of action, public health measures and procedures taken, and latest developments of the Coronavirus (Covid-19) trend in the GCC countries.
- A press conference by the National Coronavirus Response Team is scheduled today at 1:30 pm.
- A Group of Members of Parliament demanded that the Ministerial Cabinet cancels its decision to give parents the choice between sending their children to schools or continue the remote learning, requesting schools to only offer online classes when the new academic year resumes on September 16.
- A proposal has been forwarded to the Ministerial Cabinet for announcing a timeline to reopen Worship Places.
- The Public Health and Family Medicine consultant at the Ministry of Health emphasized the role of individuals in protecting selves, families and communities from the dangers of (Covid-19).
