HIGHLIGHTS

- The mortality was a 73 year old male expatriate.
- Ministry of Industry and Commerce extended the period for companies to hold their meetings online.
- Ministry of Education and Education Quality Authority addressed protocols for returning to schools.
- Bahrain companies praised for complying with the outdoor summer work ban, reaching 99.7% compliance on outdoor works ban between midday and 4pm.
- Central Bank of Bahrain launched the contactless payment services, strengthening preventive and precautionary measures against the spread of Coronavirus.
- Bahrain Chamber of Commerce and Industry disseminated questionnaires for monitoring the economic effects of COVID19 on businesses.
- Bahrain's Sixth Aviation Premier Show has been cancelled because of the coronavirus pandemic.
- Bahrain International Circuit (BIC) will resume actions, opening to the public today.




