HIGHLIGHTS

- The mortality were: 3 male Bahraini citizens (58, 67 and 71 years old), and 3 male expatriate (42, 43 and 50 years old).
- His Royal Highness the Crown Prince: Confronting the Coronavirus requires renewed determination and continuous commitment to precautionary measures.
- Ministry of Health: Family gatherings have caused most Covid-19 cluster cases last week, and tracing details are released.
- Ministry of Health: for safety, everyone is invited to download "BeAware Bahrain" Mobile App on Smart phones.
- Ministry of Education postponed the start of the school year of public schools for two weeks to examine all educational staff.
- Ministry of Education official stressed the commitment and precautionary measures against Coronavirus to ensure institutions capability to continue educational processes in the academic year 2020/2021.
- Training workshops held in numerous educational institutions for preparation on the return of students for the new academic year.
- Minister of Labor and Social Development praised the role of the Bahrain Medical Association and its teams in supporting the health of all approach.
- Inspection Department is monitoring restaurants and cafes' operations as they resume their outdoor services.
- For months, a dedicated team has been ensuring that migrant workers are being provided proper facilities amid the Covid-19 pandemic.
- Supreme Council for the Environment's CEO participated in the ministerial meeting on Covid-19 sustainable and resilient recovery approach.
- Bahrain Airport Company (BAC): Bahrain resumed issuance of entry visas on-arrival.
