HIGHLIGHTS

 The mortality was a 64 year old female Bahraini citizen.
 His Royal Highness the Crown Prince ordered intensifying public health measures to combat the spread of Coronavirus
 during the upcoming religious occasions, and stepping-up coordination between the National Taskforce to Combat the Spread
 of Covid-19, Ministry of Health, Ministry of Interior, the two Waqf (Endowment) Directorates and Ma'atam officials. Jaffari Waqf (Endowment) Directorate: No sitting-in or processions outside Ma'atams are allowed for the remainder of religious season, and coverage is restricted to live broadcasting only.

-33,729 face-mask violations have registered as Bahrain steps up inspections and awareness campaigns to curb the spread of the coronavirus, urging people to avoid "irresponsible" gatherings and abide by health guidelines considering the recent spike


