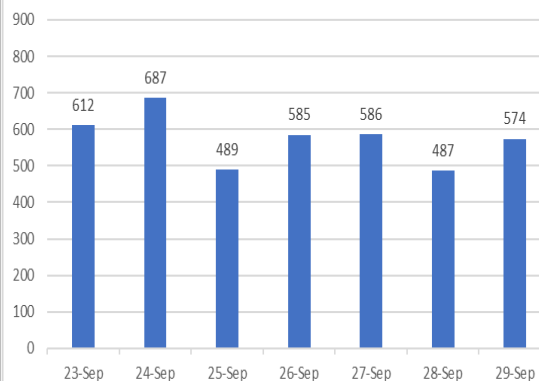

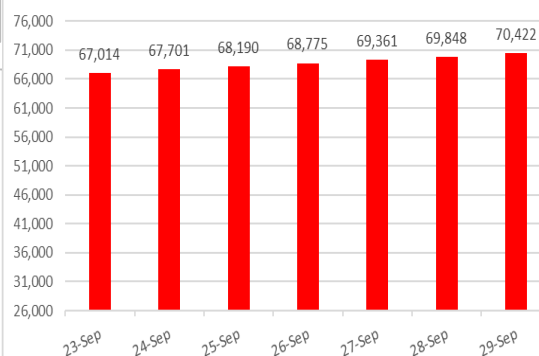
## HIGHLIGHTS

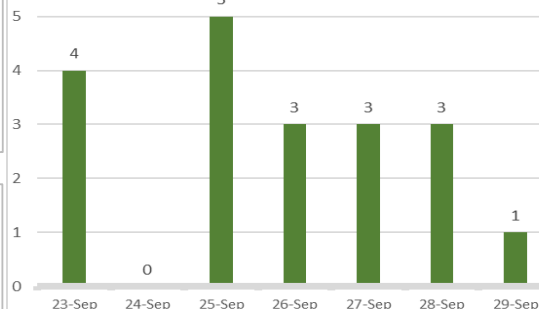
Number of New Cases
