Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19)

Situation Report No. 17 - Kingdom of Bahrain

Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 31 March 2020



HIGHLIGHTS

- Approximately 34,200 tests were conducted.
- At present there are 247 active cases still receiving treatment, 2 cases are in critical condition, and 316 individuals were discharged.
- No new mortalities recorded, and no community transmission has been reported so far.
- The National Health Regulatory Authority (NHRA) began granting private hospitals licences to treat asymptomatic cases and to provide quarantine services. Despite having spare capacity for both treatment and quarantine, the government is providing this as an option for those who would like to use private services at their own expense. Free governmental services continue to be available free of charge for all who need it.




