HIGHLIGHTS

- The mortality was a 53 year old female Bahraini Citizen.
- Once accredited by the National Health Regulatory Authority and World Health Organizations, Bahrain will be amongst the first countries in the world to provide Covid-19 vaccination.
- Ministry of Health revealed that an 11-year-old girl infected nine of her relatives.
- United Nations' flag is flown at half-mast at headquarters in New York in respect for the passing of His Royal Highness the late Prime Minister Prince Khalifa bin Salman Al Khalifa.
- Bahrain welcomed Britain's decision to add the kingdom to the list of safe countries for travelling to the UK.
- WHO: Typically, the success rate of candidate vaccines is 10%. With 47 #COVID19 vaccine candidates are currently in human trial, we have a very robust pipeline of vaccine candidates – the more candidates, the more opportunities for success.
