HIGHLIGHTS

• Approximately 34,900 tests were conducted.

• At present there are 228 active cases still receiving treatment, 3 cases are in critical condition, and 337 individuals were discharged.

• No new mortalities recorded, and no community transmission has been reported so far.

• The National Passports and Residents Affairs has developed a host of online services, backed up by a call centre. The new services aim at reducing contact while maintaining the provision of services. The new e-services will be provided starting the 5th of April.
