

# Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19)

## Situation Report No. 19 - Kingdom of Bahrain



Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 2 April 2020

### HIGHLIGHTS

- Approximately 36,500 tests were conducted.
- At present there are 258 active cases still receiving treatment, 3 cases are in critical condition, and 381 individuals were discharged.
- No new mortalities were recorded, and no community transmission has been reported so far.
- 66 of the new cases, were foreign labour workers in Salmabad.
- The percentage of public employees working from home will increase from 50% to 70% starting on Sunday.
- The Labour Market Regulatory Authority (LMRA) has announced the termination of monthly work fees and fees for issuing and renewing work permits for a period of three months, starting from 1 April 2020.
- Industry and Commerce Minister has issued an edict fixing the price of face masks and ensuring their availability amid soaring demand.

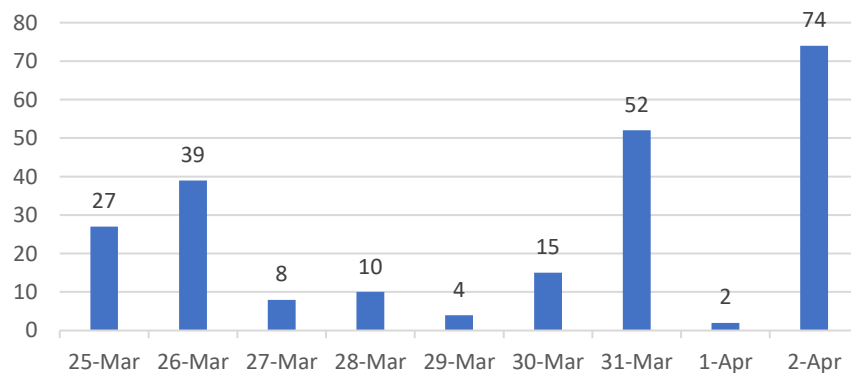
