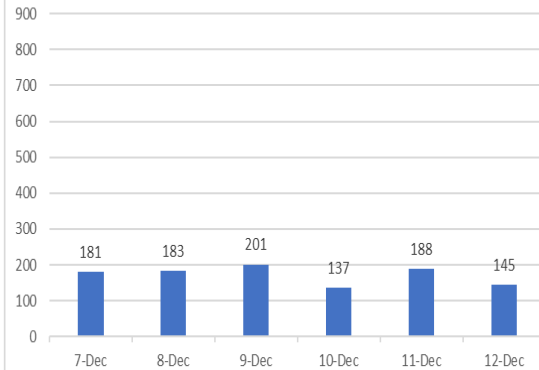

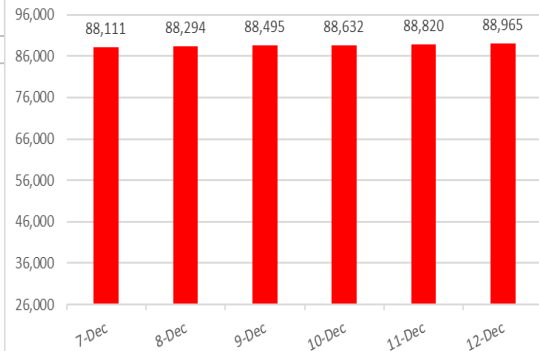
HIGHLIGHTS

- The mortality were: 7 Bahraini citizens (4 female (54, 58, 78 and 81 years old) and 3 male (60, 66 and 89 years old)).
- Bahrain will provide Covid-19 Vaccine for free to all its citizens and residents.
- Ministry of Health provided the list of pharmacies that provide COVID-19 rapid antigen test kits, delivering test results within (15) minutes on the BeAware website: <http://healthalert.gov.bh>
- H.E. Minister of Health revealed that dedicated health services will be offered to the deaf and mute within the next two years, including remote medical consultations in sign language.
- H.E. Minister of Health honors Formula 1 medical teams, lauding their amazing performance
- A new treatment protocol was introduced in main hospital to help overcome challenges of long waiting and shortage of beds.
- National Institution for Human Rights praised the Minister of Health decision specifying health requirements for accommodations to guarantee workers' rights.
- Parliament's Session ended abruptly amid a health alert that a MP tested positive for Coronavirus.
- Royal Humanitarian Foundation (RHF) donated 2,500 laptops to Bahrain University's needy students as part of the "Feena_Khaiir" campaign.

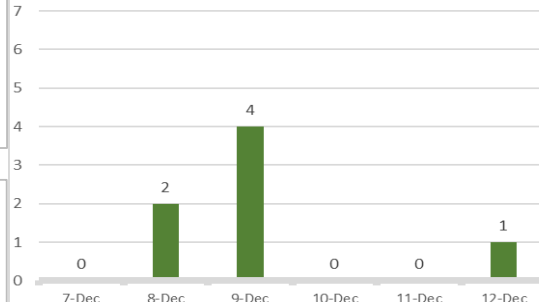
Number of New Cases
