Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 3 April 2020

HIGHLIGHTS

• Approximately 38,200 tests were conducted.

• At present there are 281 active cases still receiving treatment, 3 cases are in critical condition, and 388 individuals were discharged.

- No new mortalities were recorded, and no community transmission has been reported so far.
- The percentage of public employees working from home will increase from 50% to 70% starting on Sunday.
