HIGHLIGHTS

• Approximately 39,400 tests were conducted.

• At present there are 261 active cases still receiving treatment, 3 cases are in critical condition, and 423 individuals were discharged.

• No new mortalities were recorded, and no community transmission has been reported so far.

• A number of Bahraini citizens in Saudi Arabia were able to return to Bahrain through the King Fahd Causeway.

• The Bahrain International Airport is now allowed to receive transit passengers from all over the globe.




