Situation Report No. 22 - Kingdom of Bahrain

Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 5 April 2020



HIGHLIGHTS

- Approximately 44,400 tests were conducted.
- At present there are 265 active cases still receiving treatment, 3 cases are in critical condition, and 431 individuals were discharged.
- No new mortalities were recorded, and no community transmission has been reported so far.
- Information and eGovernment Authority started distributing electronic bracelets compatible with the COVID-19 contact tracing app "BeWare". The bracelet is mandatory for self-isolating individuals, violators face legal consequences.
- Hotline 444 for reporting new or suspected cases.


