### Situation Report No. 24 - Kingdom of Bahrain

Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 7 April 2020

### HIGHLIGHTS

• Approximately 50,200 tests were conducted.

• At present there are 341 active cases still receiving treatment, 3 cases are in critical condition, and 465 individuals were discharged.


- One new mortality recorded; a 70 year old male Bahraini citizen who had underlying chronic health conditions.
- No community transmission announced.
- Bahraini citizens from Makkah, Madinah, Taif and Jeddah have been repatriated to the Kingdom of Bahrain through the King Fahd Causeway.
- Mitigation measures extended until the 23rd of April.
- Hotline 444 for reporting new or suspected cases.


#### SITUATION IN NUMBERS Total (new) cases in last 24 hours
