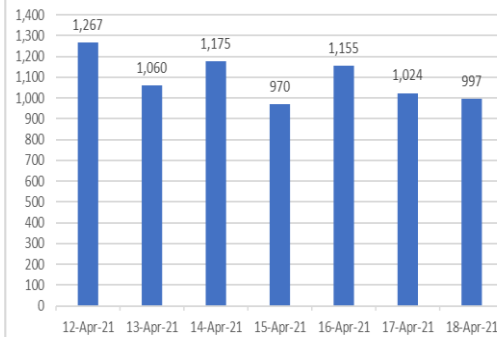

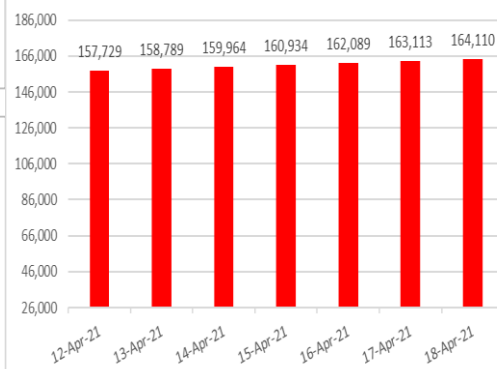
HIGHLIGHTS

- The Mortality were: 18 Bahraini citizens (10 male (46, 49, 50, 53, 61, 61, 66, 67, 74 and 81 years old) and 8 female (46, 49, 52, 54, 73, 80, 82 and 83 years old)) and expatriates (5 male (37, 57, 58, 60 and 65 years old) and 5 female (49 and 64 years old)).
- Increasing number of citizens and residents continue to take COVID-19 vaccine in Bahrain; and Ministry of Health (MOH) revealed the total number of individuals vaccinated as of 18 April 2021 for the first dose (602,644) and for the second dose (474,844).
- Ministry of Health (MOH) urges to adhere to the date and time of COVID-19 vaccination appointments.
- CEO of the Primary Healthcare Centers affirm the importance of complying with all public health measures during the holy month of Ramadan to protect the health and safety of the community and curtail the spread of the coronavirus.
- Security directorates emphasized the need to ensure compliance with all precautionary measures in public against the spread of COVID-19.
- Ministry of Justice, Islamic Affairs and Endowments has closed four mosques and a community centre for one week for failing to comply with the precautionary measures and the established health protocols.
- Friday prayer resumes: in mosques in Bahrain.
- MOH suspends classes in two schools over COVID-19 risk alert.
- MOH Undersecretary stressed Bahrain's tireless efforts to overcome the pandemic.
- New guidelines for visiting patients at Bahrain's public hospital have been announced, and enforcement will commence at Salmaniya Medical Complex (SMC) after the last day of Eid Al Fitr.

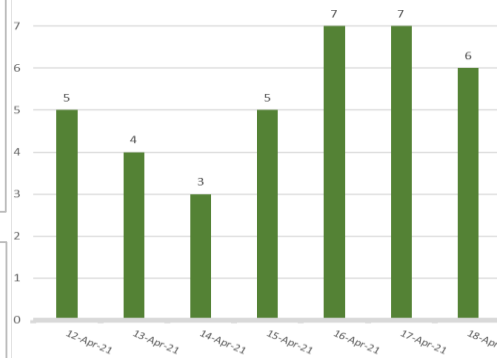
Number of New Cases
