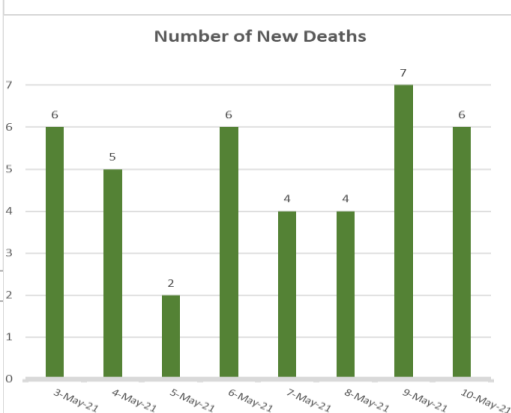
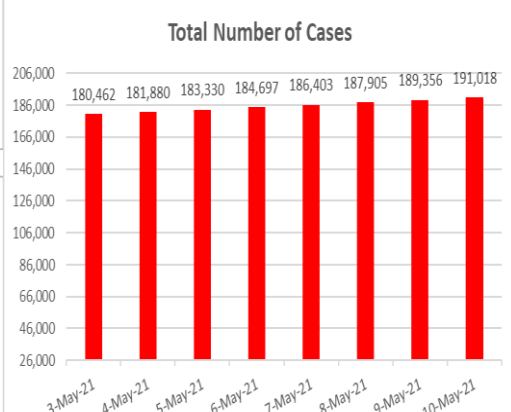
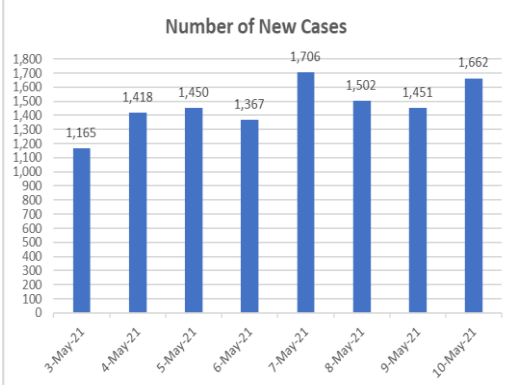

HIGHLIGHTS

- The Mortality were: 22 Bahraini citizens [12 male (32, 38, 45, 57, 70, 73, 79, 81, 85, 85 and 92 years old) and 10 Female (52, 56, 59, 62, 64, 65, 71, 73, 75 and 94 years old)] and 12 expatriates (8 male (34, 38, 44, 57, 59, 60, 62 and 69 years old) and 4 Female (43, 46, 58 and 84 years old).
- Increasing number of cases and deaths due to the COVID-19 Vaccine in Bahrain; and Ministry of Health (MOH) revealed the total number of individuals vaccinated as of 10 May 2021 for the first dose (806,143) and for the second dose (588,730).
- National Taskforce for Combating the Coronavirus reiterated importance of adhering to ALL public health re-opening procedures starting from the first Eid Al-Fitr holiday.
- Revised health and safety COVID-19 protocols were announced for restaurants and cafes, swimming pools, recreation centres for children and spas.
- National Taskforce for Combating the Coronavirus announced updates to passenger arrival procedures.
- World Health Organization's announced the approval of the "Sinopharm" vaccine for emergency use.
- High percentage of active COVID-19 cases are still not vaccinated.
- Ministry of Justice, Islamic Affairs and Endowments temporarily closed a mosque in the Capital Governorate for flouting the precautionary COVID-19 measures.
- Bahrain leads other countries with over 70% of the eligible population receiving at least one dose of a vaccination.
