Situation Report No. 26 - Kingdom of Bahrain

Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 9 April 2020

HIGHLIGHTS

• Approximately 55,100 tests were conducted.

• At present there are 363 active cases still receiving treatment, 3 cases are in critical condition, and 519 individuals were discharged.

- No mortalities and no community transmission recorded.
- Bahrain reopens shopping malls today, joining few countries worldwide in loosening restrictions imposed to slow the spread of coronavirus.
- A new feature added to 'BeAware Bahrain' app, enabling self-isolating individuals to schedule their exit tests online.
- Two million medical face masks available at supermarkets and pharmacies.
- Ministry of Health launches a COVID-19 drive-through testing centre at the Bahrain International Exhibition & Convention Centre.
- A plane carrying a group of Bahraini citizens returning from Iran arrived as part of the evacuation plan in accordance with the precautionary measures.
- Hotline 444 for reporting new or suspected cases.
