Situation Report No. 27 - Kingdom of Bahrain

Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 10 April 2020

HIGHLIGHTS

• Approximately 57,700 tests were conducted, total number of confirmed cases is 925.

• At present there are 380 active cases still receiving treatment, 3 of them in critical condition, 1 died, and 539 individuals were discharged.

• No community transmission recorded.

• The Ministry of Health announced the death of 63-year-old Bahraini national, who was suffering from underlying chronic health problems.

- Health Ministry participates in Arab League's remote meeting with Chinese COVID-19 experts.
- MoH suspends the consultation fee of 7 Bahraini Dinar for non-citizens.
- Civil Service Bureau: face masks mandatory from April 9.
- Hotline 444 for reporting new or suspected cases.





