HIGHLIGHTS

- Approximately 60,700 tests were conducted, number of newly confirmed cases is 115, bringing total to 1040.
- At present there are 479 active cases still receiving treatment, 3 cases are in critical condition, and 555 individuals were discharged.
- No new mortalities and no community transmission recorded.
- National Institution for Human Rights pays field visits to guarantine centres.
- Hotline 444 for reporting new or suspected cases.


