Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 12 April 2020



HIGHLIGHTS

- Approximately 64,000 tests were conducted, number of newly confirmed cases is 96 (all of whom were migrant workers), bringing total to 1136.
- At present there are 572 active cases still receiving treatment, 4 of them are in critical condition, and 558 individuals were discharged.
- No new mortalities and no community transmission were recorded.
- Royal Humanitarian Foundation opens donation for private sector and individuals to support national efforts to mitigate the spread of COVID-19.
- Financial donation campaign launched to combat COVID-19.
- Hotline 444 for reporting new or suspected cases.
