Situation Report No. 34 - Kingdom of Bahrain

Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 17 April 2020

HIGHLIGHTS

- Approximately 79,600 tests were conducted.
- 44 newly confirmed cases, bringing total to 1744.
- At present there are 1,011 active cases still receiving treatment, 3 of them in critical condition, and 726 individuals were discharged.
- No new mortality and no community transmission recorded.
- The Royal Humanitarian Foundation's (RHF) 'Feena Khair' Campaign is accepting financial contributions in support of the national efforts to curb the spread of the Coronavirus.
- The Ministry of Health continues random COVID-19 testing.
- The Ministry of Industry, Commerce and Tourism has pledged to intensify its field inspections to help prevent the spread of coronavirus.
- WHO releases new guidance on safe Ramadan practices in context of COVID-19 (see link below).

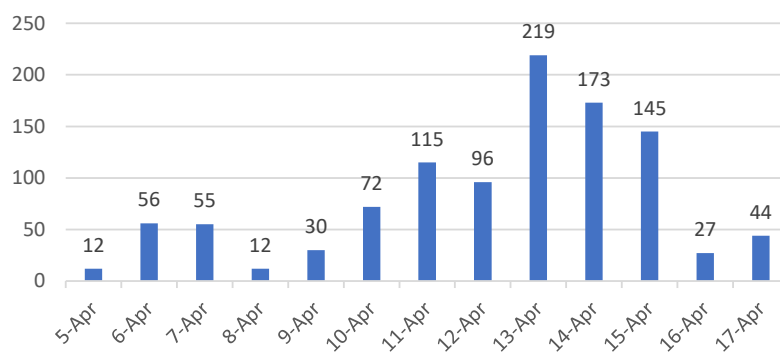
