Situation Report No. 38- Kingdom of Bahrain

Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 21 April 2020

HIGHLIGHTS

- Approximately 94,000 tests were conducted.
- 66 newly confirmed cases, bringing total to 1,973 .
- At present there are 1,182 active cases still receiving treatment, 2 of them in critical condition, and 784 individuals were discharged.
- No new mortality and no community transmission recorded.
- The government proceeds with relocating expatriate workers to reduce the density within their accommodations.
- Bahrain will continue to extend the closure of most public recreational activities' centres' and the implementation of most precautionary health measures until May 7. It also banned most traditional Ramadan gatherings and events.


