HIGHLIGHTS

- Approximately 107,300 tests were conducted.
- 408 newly confirmed cases, bringing total to 2,506. No explanation available yet for the sharp increase in new cases.
- At present there are 1,397 active cases still receiving treatment, 1 of them in critical condition; 1,113 individuals were discharged.
- No mortality and no community transmission reported.
- A number of buses modified to become mobile testing units to aid random testing for COVID-19.
- Bahraini citizens studying in the US and UK received care packages filled with essential goods and food from their embassies, as local supermarkets and pharmacies experience shortages due to the coronavirus pandemic.
- WHO launches an online course on managing COVID-19 cases and outbreaks in aviation (see link below).




