# Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19)

Situation Report No. 42 - Kingdom of Bahrain Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 25 April 2020

## **HIGHLIGHTS**

- Approximately 110,400 tests were conducted.
- 83 newly confirmed cases, bringing total to 2,589.
- At present there are 1,421 active cases still receiving treatment, 2 of them in critical condition; 1,160 individuals were discharged.
- No mortality and no community transmission recorded.

• Ministry of Health: Transferring of citizens from precautionary guarantine centres to home guarantine in accordance with the regulations for isolation. Follow up of home quarantine through the BeAware application and electronic bracelets.

• The Bahraini International Coronavirus Webinar was launched with the participation of a group of international specialists and consultants on Saturday 25 April 2020.

• WHO launches an online course on managing COVID-19 cases and outbreaks in aviation (see link below).






