Situation Report No. 45 - Kingdom of Bahrain

Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 28 April 2020

HIGHLIGHTS

- Approximately 121,700 tests were conducted.
- 88 newly confirmed cases, bringing total to 2,811.
- At present there are 1,493 active cases still receiving treatment, 2 of them in critical condition; and 1,310 individuals were discharged.
- No new mortality and no community transmission recorded.
- Three defendants sentenced for violating health regulations and fined BD 1,000 each.
- Car traffic reduced across Bahrain as people observe anti-coronavirus measures. The decline reached 90% in the morning and 85% in the evening.
- The capacity of the isolation centres is 1673, the occupancy is 902, and in the private sector centres the capacity is 801, and the occupancy is 20.
- WHO document provides guidance regarding the operation of immunization programs in the context of the COVID-19 pandemic (see link below).

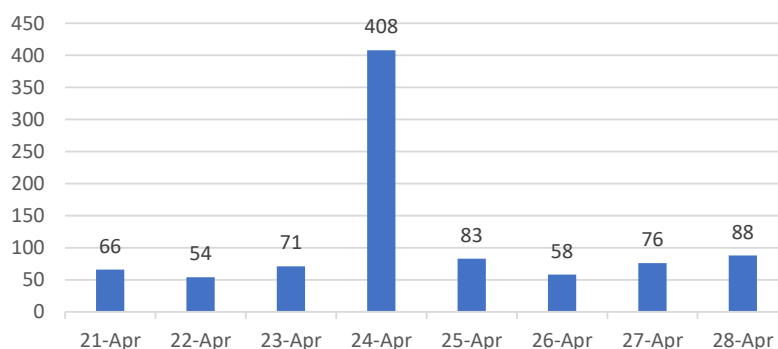
