HIGHLIGHTS

- Approximately 127,000 tests were conducted.
- 110 newly confirmed cases, bringing total to 2,921.
- At present there are 1,458 active cases still receiving treatment, 1 of them in critical condition, and 1,455 individuals were discharged.
- No mortality and no community transmission recorded.
- Health centres launch chronic disease medicine home delivery.
- The Bahrain Institute for Public Administration (BIPA) and the Arabian Gulf University (AGU), form a joint research team, in coordination with the Supreme Council for Health (SCE), to study the concept of crisis-based innovation amidst the Coronavirus (Covid-19) pandemic.
- WHO document provides guidance regarding the operation of immunization programs in the context of the COVID-19 pandemic (see link below).
