HIGHLIGHTS

- Approximately 139,400 tests were conducted.
- 363 newly confirmed cases, bringing total to 3,284.
- At present there are 1,708 active cases still receiving treatment, 1 of them in critical condition, and 1,568 individuals were discharged.
- No mortality recorded and no community transmission recorded.
- 276 Bahrainis evacuated from Jordan .
- The Health Affairs Department in the Ministry of Interior launches a voluntary campaign to deliver medicines for patients with chronic diseases to their homes.
- Bahrain's governorates and police departments team up with a large number of volunteers to provide 16,000 Ramadan fast breaking meals across the Kingdom.




