HIGHLIGHTS

- Approximately 149,600 tests were conducted.
- 150 newly confirmed cases, bringing total to 3,533.
- At present there are 1,781 active cases still receiving treatment, 1 of them in critical condition, and 1,744 individuals were discharged.
- No mortality recorded and no community transmission recorded.
- Bahrain has set up another field ICU with 154 beds on a man-made island, the second of five hospitals authorities plan to build in case of a coronavirus spike.




