## Situation Report No. 51 - Kingdom of Bahrain

Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 06 May 2020

### HIGHLIGHTS

- Approximately 160,400 tests were conducted.
- 214 newly confirmed cases, bringing total to 3,934.
- At present there are 2,066 active cases still receiving treatment, 4 of them in critical condition, and 1,860 individuals were discharged.
- No mortality and no community transmission recorded.
- Bahrain evacuates 144 citizens from Jordan.
- National Taskforce: The Kingdom's basic reproductive number (R0) stands at 1.4, for the past 14 days.
- The Ministry of Health, has introduced a free dedicated chat service on WhatsApp in Arabic and English to deliver up-to-date information on the spread of COVID-19 and Bahrain's response to the global pandemic.
- Shops and industrial enterprises in Bahrain re-open on Thursday while restaurants stay closed to in-house diners.


