#### **HIGHLIGHTS**

- Approximately 184,000 tests were conducted.
- 167 newly confirmed cases, bringing total to 4,941.
- At present there are 2,863 active cases still receiving treatment, 2 of them in critical condition, and 2,070 individuals were discharged.
- No mortality and no community transmission recorded.
- The Ministry of Health: About 9 million visits to the ministry's website since the first case of Corona was registered.




