HIGHLIGHTS

- Approximately 190,800 tests were conducted.
- 216 newly confirmed cases, bringing total to 5,157.
- At present there are 3,076 active cases still receiving treatment, 6 of them in critical condition; 2,152 individuals were discharged.
- No mortality recorded and no community transmission recorded.
- WHO has published new guidance on Surveillance strategies for COVID-19 infection (see link below).
