HIGHLIGHTS

- Approximately 197,900 tests were conducted.
- 374 newly confirmed cases, bringing total to 5,531.
- At present there are 3,330 active cases still receiving treatment, 5 of them in critical condition; 2,192 individuals were discharged.
- 1 new mortality was recorded (80-year-old male national) and no community transmission recorded.
- The Minister of Health: Increasing the capacity of isolation and treatment centres to 4,257 beds and quarantine centres to 5,489 beds.
- 31 cases of coronavirus in one family as a result of not taking precautionary measures.
- Smokers are more likely to develop severe disease with COVID-19, compared to non-smokers. (see link below).


