Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19)

Situation Report No. 57 - Kingdom of Bahrain

Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 16 May 2020

HIGHLIGHTS

- Approximately 230,200 tests were conducted.
- 931 newly confirmed cases in 3 days, bringing total to 6,747.
- At present there are 3,973 active cases still receiving treatment, 3 of them in critical condition, and 2,762 individuals were discharged.

• 2 new mortalities bringing total to 12; the mortalities were a 67-year-old male Bahraini national and a 53-year-old male expatriate.

- No community transmission recorded.
- Specialist at the Military Hospital: Convalescence plasma is our guide to overcoming Covid-19 after its positive results.
- Embassy in Jakarta evacuates Bahraini nationals in Indonesia.

• WHO: Smokers are more likely to develop severe disease with COVID-19, compared to non-smokers; WHO has published new guidance on "Cleaning and disinfection of environmental surfaces in the context of COVID-19"; WHO provided guidance on school related public health measures (see links below).




