Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 30 May 2020

HIGHLIGHTS

- Approximately 309,600 tests were conducted.
- 1,101 newly confirmed cases in 3 days, bringing total to 10,793.
- At present there are 4,950 active cases, 13 of them in critical condition; 5,826 individuals were discharged.
- 1 new mortality bringing total to 16; the mortality was a 88-year-old Bahraini male.
- Minister of Labor: 8,011 workers provided with new accommodation to ensure their safety.
- Gulf Air resumes flights from Pakistan.
- Allowing the resumption of Friday prayers in Mosques that fulfil mitigation measures.
- Health Ministry inspects 4,200 beauty salons, barber shops.
- In a session organized by the WHO remotely, the national team to combat Corona virus shares Bahrain's experience in dealing with the pandemic.
- WHO released two new documents: key planning recommendations for mass gatherings in the context of COVID-19; and, technical guidance for the prevention and control of COVID-19 across long-term care services (see links below).


