HIGHLIGHTS

- Approximately 367,i00 PCR tests were conducted.
- 380 newly confirmed cases, bringing total to 14,763.
- 412 cases recovered bringing total individuals recovered to 9,468.
- 2 new mortalities: a 40-year-old male and a 73-year-old female expatriates, registered active cases of coronavirus suffering from underlying and chronic health problems.
- At present there are 5,269 active cases, 12 of them in critical condition.
- The Bahrain Red Crescent Society launches an e-service for social aid, where social aid applications can be submitted through the Society's website.
- WHO updates guidance on the use of face masks in context of COVID-19 (see link below), and stresses that mask use is only one component of a comprehensive approach to prevent and control COVID-19 and should be adopted with hand hygiene, physical distancing and other measures.




