Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 08 June 2020

HIGHLIGHTS

- Approximately 374,400 PCR tests were conducted.
- 654 newly confirmed cases marking the highest daily tally since the start of the pandemic, bringing total to 15,417.
- At present there are 5,064 active cases, 12 of them in critical condition.
- 858 cases recovered bringing total individuals recovered to 10,326.
- One new mortality, a 72-year-old male Bahraini national, a registered active case suffering from underlying and chronic health problems.
- Bahrain News Agency attends UNA (Union of Organization of Islamic Cooperation News Agencies) workshop on vetting news during crises, COVID-19 rumours.
- The National Institution for Human Rights (NIHR):Bahrain has taken several measures to ensure the elderly's protection from infection with the Corona virus.
- WHO updates guidance on the use of face masks in context of COVID-19 (see link below), and stresses that mask use is only one component of a comprehensive approach to prevent and control COVID-19 and should be adopted with hand hygiene, physical distancing and other measures.




